
IDENTIFYING AND ASSESSING ASSETS OF CULTURAL SUSTAINABILITY

What is sustaining your community's culture on an ongoing basis and how? In this workshop, participants identify assets of cultural sustainabilily unique to their community, create criteria for assessing their well-being, and explore how they impact collective cultural sustainabiliy.

PROCESS

This project consists of two workshops. In the first, community members use themes of sustainability particular to culture to identify assets of cultural sustainability unique to their community.

In a second workshop, assets are assessed for their wellbeing and how they impact themes. This all results in a thematic "Cultural Sustainability Profile" and customized toolkit for repeated use in monitoring cultural sustainability.
